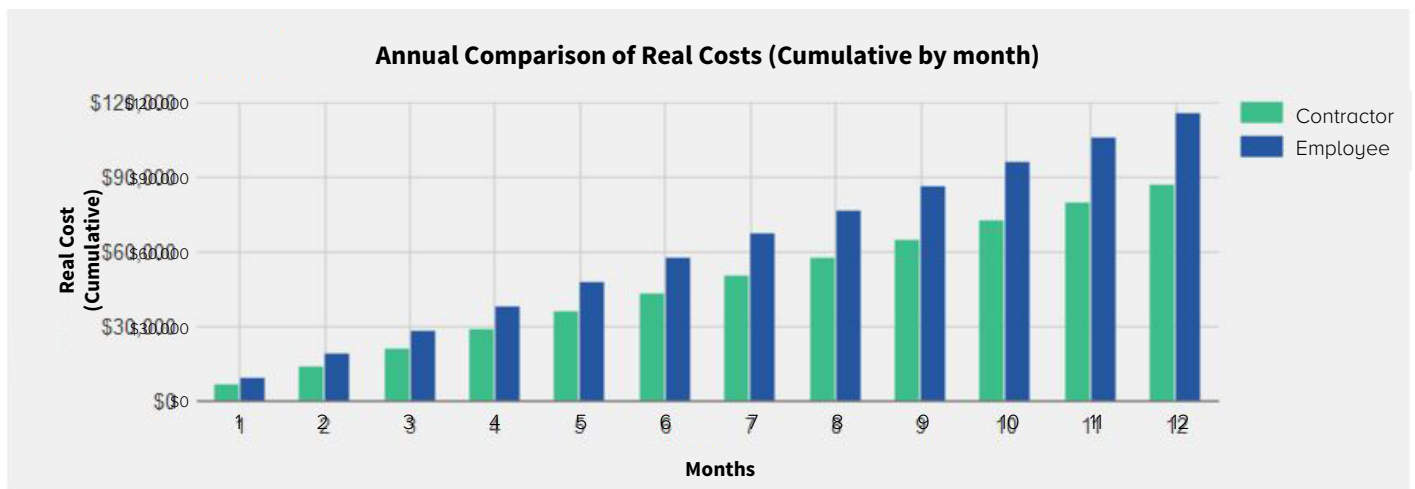

However, in this scenario the contractor will not sign-off on drawings but will be liable to produce work at the quality pre-determined.</p>

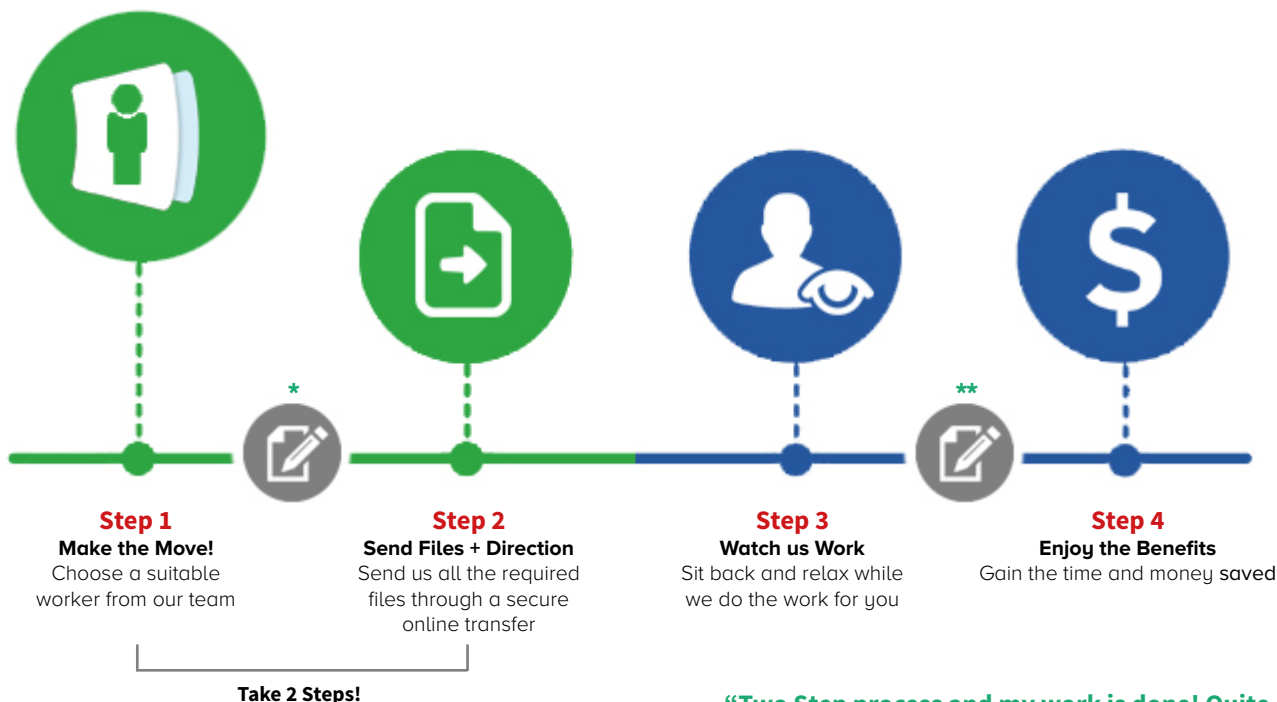
